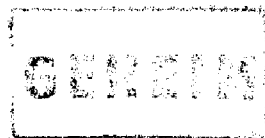

**Indonesia****SUKARNO'S AND SUBANDRIO'S WORRIES OVER LACK OF AFRO-  
ASIAN SUPPORT FOR WEST IRIAN POLICIES**  

---

Upon his arrival in Djakarta on 22 October Foreign Minister SUBANDRIO said that Afro-Asian support for Indonesian policies on West Irian was slow in developing and that he had reported this to SUKARNO in Vienna on his way back from the United Nations. To SUKARNO's question as to the reason for this, SUBANDRIO had related that Ambassador to the UN SUKARDJO had alienated a large section of the Afro-Asian bloc in the course of his duties.

On 23 October SUBANDRIO received a cable from SUKARNO ordering the immediate temporary assignment of Madame SUPENI, Acting Asian Bureau Chief, to New York to attempt to remedy the situation. The cable said nothing about recalling SUKARDJO.

SUBANDRIO anticipates a peaceful settlement of the West Irian question with the Dutch by December 1961.
