Tudeh Party Cell Instructions

The following information was obtained from a well placed source believed to be reliable.

1. At a meeting of a Tudeh Party cell in Teheran on 25.9.51 the following points were made by the cell leader:

- (i) The cell was informed that all Azerbaijani Turks who were members of the Tudeh Party were expected to join the Society for Freedom of Azerbaijan (Jami'at-i-Azadi-yi-Azerbaijan).
- (ii) They were told that in the coming Majlis elections the Tudeh Party aimed to put up under various guises at least thirty candidates in the hope of securing the return of twelve to fifteen deputies who would be able to obstruct proceedings.
- (iii) On the occasion of Mihrgan (3rd October) the Party hoped to stage a large demonstration under the auspices of one of the cover societies in the Maidan-i-Fauzia in Teheran. If, however, police permission were to be withheld, they would hold meetings in the "Peace House" (the Headquarters of the Association of Partisans of Peace) and in the various district Peace Clubs throughout the town.

2. According to a further statement of a member of this cell, a Peace Congress is to be held in the "Peace House" in Teheran in about a week's time.
