1. The Z.K.-PLENUM

(a) The Z.K.-Plenum is a gathering of the 58 full members and 14 candidate members of the Z.K., normally scheduled to take place every 3 months, when the General secretary (Fuernberg) or the Chairman (Koplenig) render an account of the party's activities. Although, according to K.P.Oe. statutes, major decisions on policy can only be taken by the Plenum if it has become apparent that its actual functions are confined to purely academic discussions and formal acceptance of recommendations and orders already put into practice by the Politburo.

2. The POLITBURO

(a) The Politburo which usually meets once every fortnight consists of Koplenig (Chairman) and the following 17 members of the Z.K.:

Fuernberg, Dr. Altmann, Frau Altmann Postronetzky, Brichacek, Elser, Fiala, Ernst Fischer, Otto Fischer, Fritz, Genner, Heider, Hexmann, Honner, Horn, Louscher, Marek, Zucker-Schilling.

(b) A number of members of the Politburo are at the same time members of either the Secretariat or the Orgburo, thus ensuring complete co-ordination of the Party machinery and smooth implementation of Politburo decisions.

(c) Heinrich Fritz is responsible for organisational work within the Politburo and acts as secretary at meetings.

3. The SECRETARIAT

(a) Friedl Fuernberg as Secretary General of the K.P.Oe. acts as head of the Secretariat. Other members are Koplenig,

Dr. Altmann, Ernst Fischer, Honner, Marek, Fiala and Zucker-Schilling who share their responsibilities in the following manner:

#### 4. ORGBURO

(a) The Orgburo, in many ways the executive arm of the Politburo, supervises all questions of personnel and appointments of senior party officials. It further receives and deals with the monthly reports received from the various Landesleitungen.

(b) Friedl Fuernberg is nominally head of the Orgburo, though the actual daily routine work is conducted by Fritz and Richter.

(c) The following is the division of duties within the Orgburo:

#### 5. AGITPROP (Zentralstelle fur Volksbildung)

(a) This is the biggest and most active department within the Z.K. responsible for Party schools, general ideological training, propaganda, economic research etc.

(b) It is headed by Ernst Fischer who is assisted by the

following Referenten:

Marck, West, Franz Strobl, Leopold Spiro, Josef Foscht, Leo Ketz, Dr. Ludwig Berg, and Erich Fein who dealt with general ideological matters.

(c) Specialized subjects, mainly of an economic nature, are dealt with by the following Referenten:

Dr. Theodor Proger, Walter Stein, Leopold Hornik, Dr. Karl Horkel, Dr. Otto Langbein, Jeno Kostmann, Walter Landgraf, Karl Secher, Dr. Hans Gruemm (students, ex-Nazis etc.), Dr. Engelbert Broda (scientific affairs, nuclear fission) and Leopold Gruenwald.

#### 6. FRONT ORGANISATIONS (Abteilung für Massenorganisationen)

This department is sub-divided into various branches according to existing front organisations and normally headed by a Referent assisted by a number of specialists. Referenten are also responsible for the training of specialist speakers, activists within the respective front organisations etc.

(a) (i) The largest department, staffed by a number of Referenten and assisted by numerous specialists, is the one concerned with the Austrian T.U.C. This Referat acts in an advisory capacity on Communist infiltration within the T.U.C. and co-ordinates the activities of various Communist controlled Works Councils in USIA factories in line with expressed K.P.Oe. policy.

(c) "KINDERLAND" and "JUNGE GARDE"

(i) "Kinderland" is an organisation for children aged 6-10 but also tries to organise the parents into so-called "welfare" activities. Chairman of "Kinderland" is Dr. Franz David (member of the Z.K.) who spent a number of years in Russia and is supposed to have reached a Colonel's rank in the Russian Medical Corps.

(i) This League has managed to play an important role in camouflaged Communist activities and is believed to have 34,000 members. Its activities are closely controlled by the Z.K. through Frau Altmann-Posttranetzky, member of the Politburo.
